The 2018 Chautauqua Lake Twin Tier Boat Show will be held on July 14 at the Village Casino Docks and Village Park, 1 Lakeside Drive, Bemus Point, NY. Included in this mailing is the package of information you will need to register for this year's boat show.

- **Event Schedule**

Sunset Cruise - On Friday evening we will meet at The Lawson Center (TLC) docks at 73 Lakeside Drive in Bemus Point for an After Dinner Sunset Cruise aboard the Summer Wind at 8:00 pm. There will be a cash bar aboard the boat and a complimentary dessert station. The cost for the Friday evening event is \$15.00 per person.

Seminar - On Saturday morning at 11 o'clock, CLTT member Andy Robinson will present a seminar at The Lawson Center. Andy will be discussing the process used to restore a homemade Hacker Craft that was built by Dave Lawson's father. Andy has restored a number of boats in the TLC boat shop. Already a long-time craftsman in woodworking, Andy has been mentored in boat restoration by Dave Lawson and has gained distinction in the area.

Youth Judging - Calling all Jr. Skippers and First Mates! Our Past President Bill Reynolds will be hosting the Youth Judging Program. This event, sponsored by Hagerty Insurance Agency, is designed for youth ages 8 to 14 and brings the world of classics to a kid-friendly level. The Youth Judges are guided through the show field as a group to pre-selected boats where they will interact with the owners, allowing them to learn details, history and fun facts about each. They will use a scorecard that highlights five basic categories and is rated on a scale of 1-to-5. This is a fun event that you won't want to miss!

As in previous years, this will not be an ACBS judged show. We will be presenting a Peoples' Choice Award at end of the show. So there's no pressure to show your boat, just come and enjoy the day and the events planned!

- **Registration Form**

In an effort to make registration easier, you can bypass the Registration Tent on Saturday morning by "checking in" at the Friday night event and picking up your welcome packet there.

Our Launch Master Ken Guest and his crew will meet you upon arrival Saturday morning at the Bemus Point launch who will assist you in your launch and stow trailers as needed. At the close of the show in the afternoon, the launch crew will be available to reload exhibitors' boats again.



Please note that there will be pre-assigned docking.
