



To CLTT Boat Show Participants:

The 2019 Chautauqua Lake Twin Tier Boat Show will be held on Saturday, July 13 at the Village Casino Docks and Village Park, 1 Lakeside Drive, Bemus Point, NY. Included in this mailing is the package of information you will need to register for this year's boat show.

- **What's New**

June 5 Early Registration Deadline/No Late Fee - There is one price for the show this year (no late fee). The early registration date is June 5, which is earlier than previous years. This allows us time to print and distribute the program booklets and order the correct number of t-shirts. If you register as a boater or vendor by June 5, you will get your boat listed in the Boat Show Program. You will also get to request your size t-shirt and you'll get a \$10 coupon for the Ship Store in your welcome packet.

- **Event Schedule**

Welcome Reception - On Friday evening we will meet at the Hotel Lenhart at 20-22 Lakeside Drive in Bemus Point for a Welcome Reception from 4:00-6:00 pm. There will be a cash bar and complimentary appetizers. The cost for the Friday evening event is \$15.00 per person. CLTT members and their guests as well as our show vendors and sponsors are invited to attend. If you do not want to register a boat but would like to attend the Friday Welcome Reception, send in a registration form with the appropriate boxes checked and your money included. The cutoff date is June 5th for registration. Please register early.

Registration & Launch - Stop by the Registration Tent on Saturday morning to "check in" and pick up your welcome packet there. Late arrivals (after 10:00 am) can pick up your welcome packet at the INFO Tent.

Our Launch Master, Ken Guest and his crew will meet you upon arrival Saturday morning at the Bemus Point launch who will assist you in your launch and stow trailers as needed. At the close of the show in the afternoon, the launch crew will be available to reload exhibitors' boats again.

Docking - Please note that there will be pre-assigned docking at the Village Casino. Dock spaces will be shown on the Dock Map on our website as we get closer to the date of the show.

Show Times - Our show starts at 10:00 am and ends at 4:00 pm. Skippers will be called to "Start Your Engines" at 2:00 pm.

Youth Judging - Calling all Jr. Skippers and First Mates! Our Past President Bill Reynolds will be hosting the Youth Judging Program. This event, sponsored by Hagerty Insurance Agency, is designed for youth ages 8 to 14 and brings the world of classics to a kid-friendly level. The Youth Judges are guided through the show field as a group to pre-selected boats where they will interact



with the owners, allowing them to learn details, history and fun facts about each. They will use a scorecard that highlights five basic categories and is rated on a scale of 1-to-5. This is a fun event that you won't want to miss!

As in previous years, this will not be an ACBS judged show. We will be presenting a People's Choice Award at end of the show. So there's no pressure to show your boat, just come and enjoy the day and the events planned!

- **Boat Show Registration Form**

The Boat Show Registration Form is to be used to register boats to be displayed both in the water and on land. Boat show entrants will receive one complimentary Boat Show t-shirt in their goodie bag. Boaters who are registered before June 5 will ensure their boat is listed in the Boat Show Program, will receive a \$10 coupon for the Ship Store, and will ensure they receive their requested size t-shirt.

- **Vendor Registration Form**

The Vendor Registration Form is to be used for both vendor space and boats for sale in the "Field of Dreams" area within the park. Vendors are encouraged to register before June 5 to ensure space is available, receive their requested size t-shirt, and receive a \$10 coupon for the Ship Store. Vendors are invited to attend our Welcome Reception on Friday evening.
